The Service to Mankind Award is the highest honor Sertoma can bestow on a nonmember. The award honors outstanding volunteer service to the community, which comes in many forms. Past recipients have included educators, foster parents, volunteer camp directors, activists – people who make a significant volunteer contribution to those in need.

The Service to Mankind Award was adopted in Asheville, N.C., at the 1954 International Convention. The first International Service to Mankind Award was presented in 1955 to a dentist from Albuquerque, N.M., for his exemplary community efforts.

The Sertoman of the Year Award is the top recognition award that a club can give to one of its members. The award should be based on the member's Service to Mankind contributions to Sertoma and the community.

A Sertoman can receive the International Sertoman of the Year Award only once. District and International Officers selected as club or District Sertoman of the Year cannot be recognized beyond the District level during the year(s) they hold office.

Carefully review the Entry Format and Judge's Sheet. Be sure all required information is complete and correct. Make sure that you are using the most current Entry Format. Award Format can be found in the Sertoma Club Manual, on the Sertoma Web site, or by contacting Sertoma Headquarters.
